  - 1. 1 Cor. 9:17
  - "For if I do this thing willingly, I have a reward: but if against my will, a dispensation of the gospel is committed unto me."



A. IT IS USED FOUR TIMES IN THE KJB NEW TESTAMENT.

### 2. Ephesians 1:10

"That in the <u>dispensation</u> of the fulness of time<u>S</u> he might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven, and which are on earth; *even* in him:" (cf. Gal. 3:16, 4:4)

A. IT IS USED FOUR TIMES IN THE KJB NEW TESTAMENT.

### 3. **Ephesians 3:2**

"If ye have heard of the <u>dispensation</u> of the grace of God which is given me to you-ward:"

A. "DISPENSATION" IS USED FOUR TIMES IN THE KJB NEW TESTAMENT.

#### **4.** Colossians 1:25

"Whereof I am made a minister, according to the <u>dispensation</u> of God which is given to me for you, to fulfil the word of God;"



# THE MEANING OF THE GREEK WORD TRANSLATED DISPENSATION

### B. THE GREEK WORD IS OIKONOMIA.

- 1. This noun occurs 7 times in the New Testament. (Similar words: 18 times)
  - a. As we have seen, four times it is translated "dispensation."
  - b. In addition, it is translated "stewardship." three times.
    - i. It is an "administration" delegated to man by God for a period of time.



# THE MEANING OF THE GREEK WORD TRANSLATED DISPENSATION

### THE GREEK WORD IS <u>OIKONOMIA</u>.

From two Greek words:

OIKOS = HOUSE (114X)

NOMOS = LAW (197X)

# **■ THE MEANING OF THE GREEK WORD**TRANSLATED DISPENSATIONALISM

- The various forms of the word for *dispensation* appear in the New Testament <u>eighteen</u> times.
- 1. The <u>verb</u> <u>oikonomeō</u> is used <u>once</u> in Luke 16:2 where it is translated 'to be a <u>steward.</u>'
- 2. The <u>noun oikonomos</u> appears <u>10 times</u> (Luke 12:42; 16:1, 3, 8; Romans 16:23; 1 Corinthians 4:1, 2; Galatians 4:2; Titus 1:7; 1 Peter 4:10) and is usually translated <u>'steward,' 'chamberlain' or governors</u>.
- 3. The <u>noun oikonomia</u> (feminine form) **7 times**.

# THE MEANING OF THE GREEK WORDS TRANSLATED DISPENSATIONALISM

#### 4. THE MEANING EXPANDED:

a. The management of a household or of household affairs.

<u>1a:</u> specifically, the management, oversight, administration, of other's property.

<u>1b</u>: the office of a manager or overseer, stewardship.

1c: administration, dispensation.

# THE MEANING OF THE GREEK WORD TRANSLATED DISPENSATIONALISM

- The various forms (cognates) of the word dispensation appear in the New Testament eighteen times.
- 1. The <u>noun oikonomia</u> is used <u>seven times</u> (Luke 16:2, 3, 4; 1 Corinthians 9:17; Ephesians 1:10; 3:2; Colossians 1:25). In these instances it is translated <u>'stewardship,' or 'dispensation.'</u>

- In some passages, the Greek words to follow indicate dispensation(s):
- 1. aions (translated ages or world),
- 2. genea (translated age and generation),
- 3. archaios and kairos (translated time)

"Even the mystery which hath been hid from ages (Gr. aions) and from generations (Gr. genea), but now is made manifest to his saints:" (Colossians 1:26)

AN EXAMPLE OF A GREEK WORD THAT MAY INDICATE DISPENSATION DEPENDING UPON CONTEXT:

Matthew 16:3

"And in the morning, It will be foul weather to day: for the sky is red and lowring. O ye hypocrites, ye can discern the face of the sky; but can ye not discern the signs of the times (Gr. kairos)?"

#### **EXAMPLE**

**Ephesians 3:5** 

"Which in other <u>ages</u> (Gr. <u>genea</u>) was not made known unto the sons of men, as it is now revealed unto his holy apostles and prophets by the Spirit" (Ephesians 3:5, cf., v. 21)



### **APPLICATION**

### **EXAMPLE**

**Ephesians 3:4-6** 

"Whereby, when ye read, ye may understand my knowledge in the mystery of Christ) Which in other ages (genea) was not made known unto the sons of men, as it is now revealed unto his holy apostles and prophets by the Spirit; That the Gentiles should be fellow-heirs, and of the same body, and partakers of his promise in Christ by the gospel: "



### **APPLICATION**

#### **EXAMPLE**

Matthew 28:19-20 Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you alway, even unto the end of the world [Gr. aion]. Amen.

Can be understood both ways. This is called polysemy or ambiguity.

In some passages, the Hebrew or Aramaic texts suggest dispensation(s):

Daniel 2:21 "And he [GOD] changeth the <u>times</u> and the <u>seasons</u>: he [GOD] removeth kings, and setteth up kings: he [GOD] giveth wisdom unto the wise, and knowledge to them that know understanding:"

Any person is a dispensationalist who:

- 1. Trusts Christ's shed blood and death on the Cross as final atonement rather than animal sacrifice for temporary atonement.
- 2. Worships on the first day of the week rather than Saturday.
- 3. Is not building an Ark.

THERE ARE ALLEGED CONTRADICTIONS IN THE BIBLE THAT CAN ONLY BE UNDERSTOOD BY RIGHTLY DIVIDING GOD'S TRUTH.

In <u>Gen. 4:9-12</u>, God did not kill Cain for murdering his brother. (versus) In <u>Gen. 9:6</u>, God's rules changed. ("Whoso sheddeth man's blood, by man shall his blood be shed: for in the image of God made he man.")

Mat. 10:5-15. Disciples were ordered to preach only to the Jews. (versus) In Mat. 28:18-20, Christ commanded that the gospel was to be preached to all men.

Lk. 22:35-36. What about carrying money and a weapon compared with no weapons earlier?

What about preaching the death, burial, and resurrection of the Lord compared with preaching that the gospel of the Kingdom is at hand?

What about Revelation 13:10 (KJV):

"He that leadeth into captivity shall go into captivity: he that killeth with the sword must be killed with the sword. Here is the patience and the faith of the saints."

What about picking up sticks on the Sabbath? (Numbers 15:32-35).

What about the ordinances (rites and ceremonies) in the OT?



### **DISPENSATIONAL ERRORS**

What about Israel and the Church. Roman Catholicism and many Protestants teach that God permanently rejected Israel and replaced it with the Church, called "Replacement Theology." (See 2 Sam. 7:10ff; Rom. 11:1, 25-29)

Many have adopted certain rituals from the OT dispensation, such as priests, elaborate ceremonies and liturgy with candles & incense Some claim infant baptism replaced circumcision.

What about Herbert Armstrong and the "Worldwide Church of God"?



### IMPORTANCE OF DISPENSATIONS

From an article on Sermon-Audio from

"...[S]ome will say the Bible has failed in getting its messages across. With consideration given to diminishing congregations in so many churches and the lack of christian morals in society, it is hard to believe that the Bible has been anything close to a success. I wouldn't dare to tell anyone how to lead their life. I have my beliefs, and I live my life in accordance with that belief, on the other hand, I have had so-called "christians" engaging in very non-christian behaviour interfering in my life for as long as I can remember . . . "

SOME DEFINITIONS

THE OLD SCOFIELD BIBLE SAYS:

"A DISPENSATION IS A PERIOD OF TIME DURING WHICH MAN IS TESTED IN RESPECT OF OBEDIENCE TO SOME SPECIFIC REVELATION OF THE WILL OF GOD."



### **SOME DEFINITIONS**

"Major Bible Themes" by Lewis Sperry Chafer:

"A dispensation can be defined as a stage in the progressive revelation of God constituting a distinctive stewardship or rule of life."



### SOME DEFINITIONS

"Dispensationalism Today" by Charles Ryrie:

"A concise definition is this: A Dispensation is a <u>distinguishable</u> economy in the outworking <u>of</u> God's purpose."



### AN ILLUSTRATION CHANGE OF THE RULES OF ADMINISTRATION IN A DIFFERENT ECONOMY

**Before** the economic crash, a boss or a company paid an employee 1 and a half times base pay per hour for overtime. **After** the crash, the rules changed, and only the base pay per hour was paid for overtime.

Similarly, when the economy (stewardship) under the Mosaic law failed, God changed economies.

### THE NEED FOR DISPENSATIONALISM

#### **EXAMPLES DEMONSTRATING THE NEED:**

- A. Roman Catholicism does not have a dispensational approach to Scripture. As a result, their theological system is out of control.
  - a. Priests dress similar to the OT priests.
  - b. Their offerings, rituals, mass, and other ordinances derive from a faulty theology.
- B. Covenant Theology is followed by denominations that came out of the Reformation: Presbyterians, Reformed Churches, etc. (Covenant of Works, of Grace, and of Redemption). More later.

### SALVATION IN THE DISPENSATIONS GOD'S GRACE

- "The <u>basis</u> of INITIAL salvation <u>in every age</u> is the death of Christ, ACCORDING TO THE SCRIPTURES (shedding of His blood). (Heb. 9:22; 10:10)
- "The <u>requirement</u> for salvation in every age is <u>FAITH</u>. (Rom. 4, Heb. 11:6, etc., etc.) (pistueo)
- "The <u>object</u> of salvation in every age is <u>the</u> <u>God of the Bible</u>, (Deut 4; 6 (Shema), 11, Act 27:25)
- "The content of faith changes in every age." This is "Progressive Revelation." (Covenants)



### ANOTHER WRONG CHARGE AGAINST DISPENSATIONALISM

Daniel P. Fuller, Northern <u>Baptist</u> Theological Seminary, Chicago, 1957, said:

"Ignorance [by those who teach and believe Dispensationalism] is bliss, and it may well be that this popularity would not be so great if the adherents of this system knew the historical background of what they teach....."

### WRONG CHARGES AGAINST DISPENSATIONALISM

### **Fuller continues:**

"Few indeed realize that the teaching of Chafer came from Scofield, who in turn got it through the writings of [John] Darby [1800-1882] and the Plymouth Brethren."

### THIS IS FALSE AND WE WILL ADDRESS IT.



## THEOLOGY: THE STUDY OF GOD THEOLOGY IS DIVIDED INTO TWO MAJOR DIVISIONS:

- 1. DISPENSATIONAL (BAPTIST) THEOLOGY
  - A. HOWEVER, THERE ARE BAPTISTS WHO CALL THEMSELVES CALVINISTS, SOVEREIGN GRACE BAPTISTS, ETC. THIS IS WRONG.
- 2. COVENANT (PROTESTANT, RC) THEOLOGY



### POSTMODERN MOVEMENT CHURCHES, EVEN BAPTISTS, ARE CAUGHT UP IN COVENANT THEOLOGY

- 1. COVENANT (CALVINISM) THEOLOGY: TULIP
  - a. T = TOTAL DEPRAVITY
  - b. U = UNCONDITIONAL ELECTION
  - c. L = LIMITED ATONEMENT
  - d. I = IRRESISTABLE GRACE
  - e. <u>P</u> = PERSEVERANCE
- 2. COVENANT'S "REPLACEMENT THEOLOGY"



The word covenant(s) mentioned 300 times. It does not include words such as promise(s).

The **Unconditional** Covenants mentioned in the Bible are:

Literal and eternal and made by an eternal and covenantmaking God with a covenant people (Israel).

I am a <u>literalist</u> because of the <u>literal</u> fulfillment of prophecy (*e.g.,* over 300 specific prophecies about Jesus Christ). (This means literal <u>interpretation</u>; we realize there is abundant typology in the Bible, which is not used to establish doctrine, but to confirm it.)



### The **FIVE** Critically Important **Unconditional** COVENANTS

  - A. Land
  - **B.** Nation
  - C. Blessing
- **2. Davidic:** 2 Sam. 7:8-29

  - C. Throne: rulership of posterity

### 3. Palestinian: Deut. 28:1-30:10

- A. Israel plucked off the Promised Land for unfaithfulness. (Deut. 28:63-68, 30:1-3)

- C. Messiah will return & (Deut. 30:3-6)
- D. They will be restored to the land. (Deut. 30:5)

### A. THE MESSIAH

### The <u>Conditional</u> Covenants or Requirements or Agreements

- 1. There are many in Scripture:
  - a. Salt Covenant (Nu. 18:19; Col. 4:6).
  - b. Covenant of Circumcision (Gen. 17:13).
  - c. Covenant besides the Covenant at Horeb. (Deut. 29:1, 14-15).
  - d. Covenant of Peace (with Phinehas, Nu. 25:11-12).
  - e. Covenant with the House of David (1 Sam. 20:16).
  - f. Hebron Covenant (1 Chron. 11:3).



### The <u>Conditional</u> Covenants or <u>Requirements</u> or <u>Agreements</u>

- 2. Many are associated with the change in dispensations.
  - a. Edenic
  - b. Adamic
  - c. Noahic
  - d. Mosaic



- 1. There is **great confusion about Israel and the church**. Covenant theologians believe the church replaced Israel or there is a blurring of the distinctiveness.
  - a. Therefore, the OT promises to Israel are fulfilled in the church. This is absolutely wrong.

#### 1 Corinthians 10:32:

"Give none offence, neither to the Jews, nor to the Gentiles, nor to the church of God:" [This was given after formation of the church; Israel still continuing. (cf. Rom. 11)]



- 2. They <u>allegorize</u> a large part of the Scripture, particularly eschatological (prophecy) Scripture. (33+% of Scripture is prophecy).
  - a. Example: The Millennium is not literally a thousand years, simply a long, undetermined time.
  - b. The tribulation period is simply the tribulation of saints over the centuries.



- 3. Soteriological (Salvation) Confusion.
  - a. Claims **primary goal of creation is the salvation of man.** Rather, it is to the glory of God—the unifying theme of all dispensations. (Isa. 42:8; Rev. 4:11)
  - b. If the major emphasis is Man's salvation, it makes "man" central in creation as opposed to God. This is part of "selfism."
- 4. Places an emphasis on constructed covenants.
- 5. Covenant Theologians are often Hypercalvinists (5 point Calvinists).

- 2. The two never meet; even in eternity.
- 3. Some taught there were two ways to heaven.
  - 1) Works in the OT.
  - 2) Faith in NT.

#### FOUR DISPENSATIONAL APPROACHES

### II. MODIFIED DISPENSATIONALISM

- 1. Israel and the church will be together after the Millennium.
- 2. There is only one way to salvation in OT & NT.
- 3. There is only one New Covenant that is shared by both Israel and the church.

#### III. FURTHER MODIFIED DISPENSATIONALISM

- 1. The church is not a parenthesis but the first step towards establishing the Kingdom of God.
- God does not have two purposes, Israel & the church—one purpose and both share.
- 3. There is no distinction in the future state between Israel & the church.
- 4. The church will reign (with Jews) in glorified bodies on earth during the millennium. But, the OT prophecies regarding Israel will be fulfilled in the millennium by ethnic Jews. They do not see the church as the new Israel or believe that OT prophecies are fulfilled in the church.

#### IV. ULTRA OR HYPER DISPENSATIONALISM

- 1. Variations of when the church began (e.g., either Acts 9, 13, 28).
- 2. The ordinances of either baptism or the Lord's Supper does not apply to the church.
- 3. Some even see "two" churches.
- 4. Some teach the dispensations are sealed of one from the other.
- 5. The four Gospels are entirely Jewish.





It did not begin with John Darby (1800-1882)!

This is a classic argument against dispensational theology that is not true.

It began with God. Other Ante-Nicene Church elders also mentioned "ages" or "dispensations" or "covenants" or "courses" in the differing periods such as Irenaeus (c. 125 – c. 202 A.D.).



- <u>Irenaeus</u> (c. 125 c. 202 A.D.) was a disciple of Polycarp. Polycarp was discipled by the Apostle John. Irenaeus said:
- "... and the gospel is quadriform, as is also the course [dispensations] followed by the Lord. For this reason were four principle covenants given to the human race: one, prior to the Deluge, under Adam; the second, that after the Deluge, under Noah; the third, the giving of the law, under Moses; the **fourth**, that which renovates man, and sums up all things in itself by means of the Gospel, raising and bearing men upon its wings into the heavenly kingdom.



#### OTHERS WHO MENTIONED DISPENSATIONS:

- 1. Justin Martyr (110-165 A.D.)
- 2. Clement of Alexandria (<u>150-220</u> A.D.)
- 3. <u>Even</u> Augustine (<u>354-430</u> A.D.): "The divine institution of sacrifice was suitable in the former dispensation, but is not suitable now. God...knows ...what is suitable for every <u>age</u>."
- 4. Pierre Poiret (1646-1719 A.D.)
- 5. John Edwards (<u>1639-1716</u> A.D.) published two volumes: "A Complete History or Survey of All the Dispensations."

RATHER, THE AUTHORITY IN THE MATTER IS GOD'S WORDS, OUR "FINAL AUTHORITY"!

## THE MEANING OF THE GREEK WORD TRANSLATED DISPENSATIONALISM

### B. THE GREEK WORD IS OIKONOMIA.

- 1. It comes from two Greek words:
  - a. oikos = oikos = house
  - β. νομος = nomos = law

#### 2. It means:

- a. the law of the household, or
- b. the method of administrating the household.

## THE MEANING OF THE GREEK WORD TRANSLATED <u>DISPENSATIONALISM</u>

- 3. Please note that the meaning has to do with two aspects:
  - a. A period of time (not as important).
  - b. The "method" or "system" of the stewardship.

#### SOME FACTS ABOUT DISPENSATIONALISM

- 1. Dispensations are <u>NOT</u> about salvation or how you are saved.
- 2. God's orderly "Progressive Revelation "
  through seven dispensations to try man's
  faithfulness (not his salvation).
- 3. God is demonstrating that man needs a Shepherd; man is not capable of managing himself.

#### SOME FACTS ABOUT DISPENSATIONALISM

- 4. Throughout the dispensations, there is <u>order</u> outlined in responsibilities.
- 5. Even amongst the Trinity, there is order or division of responsibilities.
  - a. 1 Corinthians 12:4-6 (KJB) "Now there are diversities of gifts, (CFO) but the same Spirit. And there are differences of administrations, (COO) but the same Lord. And there are diversities of operations, (CEO) but it is the same God which worketh all in all."



#### SOME FACTS ABOUT DISPENSATIONALISM

6. GRACE WAS PRESENT IN THE GARDEN AS A GIFT OF GOD. IT IS NOT A COVENANT. GOD IS GRACE.

### John 1:14 (KJV)

(KJV) And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.



### SALVATION IN THE DISPENSATIONS

- "The <u>basis</u> of salvation in every age is the death of Christ, ACCORDING TO THE SCRIPTURES
- "The <u>requirement</u> for salvation in every age is <u>FAITH</u>,
- "The <u>object</u> of salvation in every age is <u>the</u> <u>God of the Bible</u>,
- "The content of faith changes in every age." This is "Progressive Revelation."



#### UNDERSTANDING DISPENSATIONALISM

#### **EXAMPLES:**

- Without a doubt, we are to serve (work) for him, but there is not a covenant of works
   (Eph. 2:8-9; Rom. 11:6). Work in the Garden was part of the responsibilities for that dispensation (to care for the garden, Gen. 2:15).
- The grace of God was present in the Garden, also; He did not destroy Adam and Eve and creation after "the fall of man."



### UNDERSTANDING DISPENSATIONALISM

#### **EXAMPLES:**

 Without a doubt, redemption is and was in the plan of God, which was first seen in the Garden (Gen. 3:15, 21) and throughout man's history (1 Pe. 1:18-19, Rev. 13:8, 1 Pe. 1:20).

THE PROTO EVANGELICALISM

## THERE MUST BE AND THERE IS A DISTINCTION IN ADMINISTRATIONS

(Galatians 4:4-5)

"But when the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law, To redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons. (note "time" is singular)

- Remember, Paul made it clear that we must "<u>Study</u> to shew thyself <u>approved</u> unto God, <u>a workman that needeth</u> not to be ashamed, <u>rightly dividing the word of truth</u>."
  - (2 Timothy 2:15)



## THERE MUST BE AND THERE IS A DISTINCTION IN ADMINISTRATIONS

#### **Ephesians 1:10:**

- That in the dispensation of the fulness of time S he might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven, and which are on earth; even in him: (note "time" is plural) (cf. Gal. 3:16).
- Remember, Paul made it clear that we must "Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth." (2 Timothy 2:15)



### THERE MUST BE AND THERE IS A DISTINCTION IN ADMINISTRATIONS

In the book of John it says:

John 1:17

"For the law was given by Moses, but grace and truth came by Jesus Christ."

This is a clear distinction in stewardship or administration or dispensation by God from the OT to the NT.



### PROPER INTERPRETATION OF THE BIBLE IS CRITICAL

The "Golden Rule of Bible Interpretation"

"When the plain sense of Scripture makes common sense, seek no other sense. Therefore take every word at its primary, ordinary, usual, literal meaning, unless the facts of the immediate context and axiomatic and fundamental truths indicate clearly otherwise."

Of course there are "figures of speech" in the Bible, but the rule prohibits us from using figures of speech to establish a doctrine.


## PROPER INTERPRETATION OF THE BIBLE IS CRITICAL

WE MUST NOT BRING OUR IDEAS TO THE SCRIPTURE (CALLED DEDUCTIVE REASONING) BUT WE MUST LET SCRIPTURE DICTATE TO US ITS INTERPRETATION (CALLED INDUCTIVE **REASONING**)



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## THE CARDINAL RULES FOR INTERPRETATION

- 1. When the plain sense of Scripture makes common sense, seek no other sense.
- 2. Use only the clear statements of Scripture to establish a doctrine., then apply it to the less clear statements in Scripture.
- 3. Pay particular attention to the first occurrences of a word.
- 4. Examine the word, then the phrase, then the sentence (or verse), then the passage, then the other uses by the author, then the entire Bible.



## THE RUE OVER <u>PROGRESSIVE</u> DISPENSATIONALISM

- 1. P.D. is being taught at a number of seminaries such as Northwestern Theological Seminary in St. Paul and Central Theological Seminary in Plymouth, MN by Professor Edward Glenny, Dallas Theological Seminary in Dallas, TX. Dr. Swindoll is there. When Dr. Chafer was there, they trained their students in CLASSIC Dispensationalism.
- 2. Dr. Walvoord, Chancellor at DTS, said "theology is changing." If its Biblical theology, it does not change.



## THE RUE OVER <u>PROGRESSIVE</u> DISPENSATIONALISM

- 3. Formerly and correctly, I was taught that the "Sermon on the Mount" was the principles for the Kingdom <u>Age</u>, the Millennial <u>Age</u> when the King comes. The 'new' teaching of Progressive Dispensationalism is that it applies to the "Church" which replaced Israel. It is true that the 'believing' church should reflect these principles.
- 4. Furthermore, they teach that the Lord Jesus Christ is reigning ON EARTH right now. If He is reigning at present, He is making a terrible mess. The "prince of this world" is currently reigning. Of course, God is sovereign and He is the OOO God!



## HYPERDISPENSATIONALISM OR ULTRADISPENSATIONALISM

- 1. TEACHES SEPARATE DISPENSATIONS IN THE BOOK OF ACTS.
  - a. THE EXTREME: CHURCH STARTS AT ACTS 28;
  - b. MODERATES: AT ACTS 9 OR 13
- 2. FOR SOME AN ENTIRE DISPENSATION IS GIVEN TO THE PERIOD OF TIME BETWEEN CALVARY AND:
  - a. THE DESCENT OF THE HOLY SPIRIT INTO THE CHURCH, OR
  - b. THE BEGINNING OF PAUL'S MINISTRY AS THE APOSTLE TO THE GENTILES, OR
  - c. THE END OF ACTS.
- 3. E. W. Bullinger is associated with hyperdispensationalism or ultradispensationalism

## HYPERDISPENSATIONALISM OR ULTRADISPENSATIONALISM

- 1. DEPENDING ON THE THEOLOGIAN; SOME PLACE THE DIVISION IN ACTS SO THAT THERE IS:
  - a. ONE ORDINANCE (EITHER WATER BAPTISM OR THE LORD'S SUPPER), OR
  - b. NO ORDINANCE FOR THE CHURCH



## ULTRADISPENSATIONALISM (Bullingerism)

#### **SOME OF THE UNUSUAL BELIEFS**

- 1. THE GREAT COMMISSION IN MATTHEW & MARK IS JEWISH.
- 2. THE MINISTRY OF THE TWELVE APOSTLES IS A CONTINUATION OF CHRIST'S MINISTRY.
- 3. THE CHURCH DID NOT BEGIN AT PENTECOST.
- 4. WATER BAPTISM IS NOT FOR THIS AGE.
- 5. THERE IS A DIFFERENCE BETWEEN PAUL'S EARLY AND LATER MINISTRIES.
- 6. ISRAEL, NOT THE CHURCH, IS CHRIST'S BRIDE.



### THE SEVEN DISPENSATIONS

- 1. INNOCENCE
- 2. CONSCIENCE
- 3. GOVERNMENT
- 4. PATRIARCHAL OR PROMISE
- 5. LAW
- 6. GRACE OR CHURCH
- 7. MILLENNIUM OR KINGDOM

SOME SIMPLY MAKE A DISTINCTION BETWEEN LAW AND GRACE; OTHERS ONLY LAW, GRACE, AND MILLENNIUM, OR PROMISE, LAW, GRACE, MILLENNIUM.



## HYPERDISPENSATIONALISM OR ULTRADISPENSATIONALISM

HYPERDISPENSATIONALISTS CLAIM EIGHT OR MORE DISPENSATIONS BY WRONGLY DIVIDING THE BOOK OF ACTS.

Those who throw out water baptism claim there is no distinction between water baptism and circumcision. They wait eight days until they sprinkle babies, just like the act of circumcision at eight days.



- 1. WE HAVE NO GARDEN OF EDEN.
- 2. WE ARE NOT INNOCENT (WE HAVEN'T YET SINNED). NOW WE ARE SINNERS BECAUSE OF ADAM. ADAM WAS THE HEAD OF THE RACE.
- 3. WE DO NOT HAVE A PARADISE.
- 4. THE OLD TESTAMENT IS WRITTEN FOR US BUT IT IS NOT TO US. THE APOSTLES PAUL'S LETTER'S ARE TO US IN THE CHURCH AGE.



- 5. IN GENESIS 1:9-10, MAN, FOWL, AND ANIMALS WERE TO EAT THE HERBS OF THE FIELD.
  - a. WE ARE NOT HERBIVOROUS AND
  - b. MANY ANIMALS ARE NOT.
- 6. IN GENESIS 9:3, <u>AFTER THE FLOOD</u>, A TRANSITION PERIOD, MAN IS GIVEN MEAT OR FLESH TO EAT: "EVERY MOVING THING."
- 7. IN GENESIS 2:25, MAN WAS NAKED. AFTER SIN, MAN WAS TO BE CLOTHED; GOD MADE CLOTHING OF ANIMALS SKINS—THEREFORE THE SHEDDING OF BLOOD AND THE PICTURE OF REDEMPTION.



- 8. GENESIS 6:14: Noah was to build an ark. ORDERED TO BUILD IT 120 YEARS BEFORE THE FLOOD. WE ARE NOT TO BUILD AN ARK. WE HAVE AN ARK: IF YOU ARE IN HIM, YOU ARE SAFE FROM THE FLOOD OF JUDGMENT TO COME.
- 9. WE ARE NOT TOLD TO SACRIFICE ANIMALS. (ALL THE SACRIFICES FOR ISRAEL CAME TO ABOUT 1256+ EVERY YEAR (LEV. 23, NUM. 28).
- 10. WE ARE NOT TOLD TO GO TO JERUSALEM THREE TIMES A YEAR (EX. 34:23).



- 11. GOD **PERMITTED** MANY WIVES. SOLOMON HAD 1000 WIVES AND CONCUBINES.
- 12. NOW: MATTHEW 19:5-6 RULES. Spiritually means "Till death do us part" is a phrase from the marriage liturgy in the Anglican Book of Common Prayer, which uses the "us do" phrasing. The "do us" phrasing is more common in the United States.
- 13. MOSES WAS ORDERED TO BUILD A TABERNACLE. WE ARE THE TABERNALCE OF GOD IN THIS DISPENSATION.



#### 14. SOME THINGS ARE TRANSDISPENSATIONAL:

- a. Capital Punishment (Gen. 9:6, Acts 25:11, Rom. 13:4)
- b. Abstain from the eating of blood (Gen. 9:4, Acts 15:20). "The life of the flesh is in the blood."
- c. Abstain from fornication, unchaste (Lev. 21:9, 19:29, Deut. 22:20-21, 23-29; 23:18; Ex. 22:16, Mat. 19:9, Acts 15:20, 29, 1 Cor. 6:18 (porneia, and porneuo)
- d. Food offered to idols.
- e. Nine of the Ten Commandments are repeated in the NT. (Sabbath is not repeated in the NT.)

Any person is a dispensationalist who:

1. Trusts Christ's shed blood and death on the Cross rather than animal sacrifice.

2. Worships on the first day of the week rather than Saturday.


