For me, the bottom line is that Santa is not real. He is a lie. Therefore, he could not be of God, nor is he condoned by God to teach to my children. On the contrary, the Scripture says,

[&]quot;...the mouth of them that speak lies shall be stopped" (Ps. 63:11b);

[&]quot;He that worketh deceit shall not dwell within my house: he that telleth lies shall not tarry in my sight" (Ps. 101:7);

[&]quot;A false witness shall not be unpunished, and he that speaketh lies shall not escape" (Pr. 19:5).

And,

"And they shall turn away their ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables" (2 Tim. 4:4);

"Neither give heed to fables and endless genealogies, which minister questions, rather than godly edifying which is in faith: so do." (1 Tim. 1:4);

"But refuse profane and old wives' fables, and exercise thyself rather unto godliness." (1 Tim. 4:7).

Satan seeks to counterfeit everything about the Lord and tries to steal His glory. The verse that says,

"For thou hast said in thine heart...I will be like the most High" Isaiah 14:13-14

is proof of that. We would be fools to think otherwise. The Lord speaks of Satan in John 8:44,

"He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it."

We can conclude then, if Santa is a lie, he originated with Satan. As a child of the true and living King, my Father, I want nothing to do with Satan or his lies, and therefore I want nothing to do with Santa Claus nor do I want his 'presence' in my home. Instead, I want to glorify God and Him alone (see Isaiah 43:7). I will leave you with one final thought,

"I am the LORD: that is my name: and **my glory will I not give to another**, neither my praise to graven images" (Isaiah 42:8)
