INTRODUCTION



The agitation of the Black Lives Matter movement has dominated the public discourse in the United States since the death of an African American man who died during his arrest in Minneapolis. This was a tragic event. The death of Mr. Floyd was troubling indeed. However, I am also concerned over the legitimacy of the phrase "black lives matter," since all lives irrespective of race matter! Mr. Floyd's death was the spark that lit the fires of violent protests, police shootings and terrorism

in many cities across the USA by groups like Black Lives Matter, Antifa and other groups and individuals. In fact, violence is being encouraged. One Black Lives Matter leader said they would burn the system down if they don't get what they want. When Philadelphia Police shot and killed Walter Wallace who refused to drop his knife and came at them October 26, 2020 people marched through the streets shouting, "Every city every town, burn the precincts to the ground." Following was looting and violence where 30 policemen were injured.

What is at the root of all of this? I believe the foundation of all of this is a philosophy called **Critical Race Theory**.

Back in the early 70's there was a movement among liberal scholars in American law that was very obscure. It was known as The Critical Race Theory (CRT). This theory was based on the Critical Theory which was a Marxist-inspired movement in social and political philosophy first defined by Max Horkheimer of the Frankfurt School of Sociology in his 1937 essay, *Traditional and Critical Theory*. He said that the aim of all critical theory is to "create a world which satisfies the needs and powers of human beings" (see Critical Theory 1972, p. 246).

THE TEACHINGS OF CRITICAL RACE THEORY

Horkheimer drew from Karl Marx and Sigmund Freud and developed a philosophy to change society as a whole, overcoming current social structures through which people were dominated and oppressed. You could call it an emancipatory form of Marxism which overturns capitalism by revolution and replaces it with communism. The Critical Theory teaches that science, like other forms of knowledge, has been used as an instrument of oppression and they caution against a blind faith in scientific progress, arguing that scientific knowledge must not be pursued as an end in itself without reference to the goal of human emancipation. The Critical Theory birthed the Critical Race Theory which is like a fast spreading virus infecting nearly every area of society; education at every level, government, religion, the media, the work place and more.

THE DEFINITION OF CRITICAL RACE THEORY (CRT)

“CRT is the view that the law and legal institutions are inherently racist and that race itself, instead of being biologically grounded and natural, is a socially constructed concept that is used by white people to further their economic and political interests at the expense of people of colour.”

In CRT “Each individual is seen either as oppressed or as an oppressor, depending on their race, class, gender, sexuality, and a number of other categories. Oppressed groups are subjugated, not by physical force or even overt discrimination, but through the exercise of hegemonic power—the ability of dominant groups to impose their norms, values, and expectations on society as a whole, relegating other groups to subordinate positions.”

THE TEACHINGS OF CRT

THE FIRST TEACHING

- Racism is present in every aspect of life, every relationship, and every interaction; therefore its advocates look for it everywhere!

What you need to understand is that advocates of CRT use semantic word games to support their fraudulent theory. One way they do this is by redefining **racism** to fit their agenda. **What they mean by "racism" is not what most people think racism means.** It is not prejudice based upon race or believing some races to be superior or inferior to others that they mean by "racism." It is, instead, **the "system" of everything that happens in the social world and beyond, that results in any disparity that works in the favor of "racially privileged" groups (on average) or any "racially oppressed" person claiming they experience racial oppression.**

What advocates of CRT are saying is that **the basic human problem is racism!** They look for it everywhere and YOU must look for it also **or you are a racist.** You have to find and focus upon the "hidden" racism in your workplace, your school, your society, your

neighborhood, your books, your food, your music, your hobbies, your faith, your church, your community, your friends, your relationships, and yourself (and everything else too) all the time.

Their answer to the problem is that “woke” [woke=being alert to injustice in society, especially racism] whites join people of color in tearing down the existing system and replacing it with a new structure run by people of color.

Biblically, there are several MAJOR problems with their teaching. **First** of all, I remind you that this is a **theory**. Let me define **theory** for you. A **theory** is “a supposition or a system of ideas intended to explain something.” The Merriam-Webster Dictionary online says a **theory** is “a plausible or scientifically acceptable general principle or body of principles offered to explain phenomena. A **theory** is an unproved assumption. Synonyms for theory are **speculation** and **conjecture**.”

Paul warned in **1 Timothy 6:20**,

“O Timothy, keep that which is committed to thy trust, avoiding profane and vain babblings, and oppositions of science falsely so called.” .
