Galatia, even so do ye. Upon the first day of the week let every one of you lay by him in store, as God hath prospered him. [1 Corinthians 16:2, 3]

The Christian church began on the Day of Pentecost which was the first day of the week: the same day the Holy Spirit came down on the church. The Lord Jesus Christ rose from the dead on the first day of the week. That is why it is called the Lord's Day. John was given the message to the 7 churches of Asia on the Lord's Day.

I was in the Spirit on the Lord's day, and heard behind me a great voice, as of a trumpet, Saying I am Alpha and Omega, the first and the last: and, What thou seeist, write in a book, and send it unto the seven churches which are in Asia. [Revelation 1:10, 11]

The historic Christian church is connected to the Lord's Day, Sunday, on the Roman calendar as we observe it today.

 Adventists confuse and mix the Christian church and the Jew's religion (Judaism), wrongly bringing people back under the Old Testament Mosaic law. They are modern day heretical 'Judaizers' and not New Testament Christians.

All human beings on earth belong to one of 3 groups... Give none offense, neither to the Jews, nor to the Gentiles, nor to the church of God [I Corinthians 10:32]. The word "Christian" is a reference to Gentile disciples outside the land of Palestine [Acts 11:26] and the term does not show up in the Bible until the Gospel has gone outside Jewish territory (Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria). Paul never once in his 13 epistles

commanded Christian churches to observe the Jewish Sabbath. He even warned against observing the 7th day to the church at Colosse. Paul, the former Pharisee left it.

Let no man therefore judge you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of an holyday, or of the new moon, or of the sabbath days: Which are a shadow of things to come; but the body is of Christ. [Colossians 2:16, 17] The Sabbath was a shadow of things to come because it was given to the nation of Israel (the Jews) in the Mosaic law in 1500 B.C.

And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, Speak thou also unto the children of Israel, saying, Verily my Sabbaths ye shall keep: for it is a sign between me and you (Israel...not the church) throughout your generations...whosoever doeth any work in the sabbath day, he shall surely be put to death. [Exodus 31:12, 13, 15pt.]

The sabbath was a 'shadow of things to come,' that is, the New Testament Church, comprised of born-again (saved) Gentiles and Jews (Christians), which is the body of Christ. Unsaved Jews continued to observe the Sabbath in synagogues while saved Christians and Jews worshipped Jesus Christ in local churches on the Lord's Day.

James and the council at Jerusalem sent a letter with Paul and Barnabas to the church at Antioch saying, greetings unto the brethren which are of the gentiles in Antioch and Syria and Cilicia (i.e., the Christian churches). For it seemed good to the Holy Ghost, and to us, to lay upon you no greater burden than these necessary things; That ye abstain from meats offered to idols, and from blood, and from things strangled, and from fornication: from

which if ye keep yourselves, ye shall do well. Fare ye well. [Acts 15:23pt., 28-29]

Not one word of command was given by the church at Jerusalem to the Gentiles to worship on the sabbath. Instead they wrote, For Moses of old time hath in every city them that preach him, being read in the synagogues every sabbath day [v. 21]. They distinguished clearly between the Christian Church and the Jew's religion (Judaism). The Jews needed to be saved. This distinction is given in John's gospel [John 1:17].

For the law was given by Moses, but grace and truth came by Jesus Christ.

 Seventh Day Adventists are habitual and continual Sabbath-breakers.

The Bible Sabbath did NOT fall on Friday (6 pm) to Saturday (6 pm) every year, not even every other year. White followed Constantine and the Roman calendar declaring that Sunday was the first day of the week (Mar. 7, A.D. 321) she assumed that God and the Bible had to adjust to that day, so they adopted Saturday as the 7th day of the week. She forgot that the Bible calendar for all Jews is a 30-day-month calendar, and the lunar year has 360 days in it, not 365. Therefore, the Jewish Passover falls on each of 7 days over a period of 20 years. The Sabbath followed the Passover. Hence, all Adventists are habitual and continual Sabbath breakers.

5. Adventists are deceptive hiding their true identity in their publishing and outreach.

Their literature is under anonymous names such as 'Herald and Review,' Pacific Publishing Company and The Southern Publishing Company. A broadcast called,

"The Voice of Prophecy" has been conducted following these teachings. These books are filled with doctrinal poison sourced from the secretive Seventh Day Adventist Church. The New Testament gospel preachers did not hide their identity or purpose.

Therefore seeing we have this ministry, as we have received mercy, we faint not; But have renounced the hidden things of dishonesty, not walking in craftiness, not handling the word of God deceitfully; but by manifestation of the truth commending ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God. [II Corinthians 4:1-2]

6. Adventists' teachings changed through the years between 1900 and 1990.

They originally taught that a Christian had to keep all the 10 Commandments to be saved. They no longer teach that. They taught that going to church on Sunday instead of Saturday was taking the "Mark of the Beast" (Revelation 13: 16-18). They no longer teach that. They teach that those that take the Mark of the Beast will not be lost while the Bible says that they will be lost. They LIE. God and His truth (His Word) do not change.

For I am the LORD, I change not; therefore ye sons of Jacob are not consumed. [Malachi 3:6]

7. Adventists dishonour the Lord Jesus Christ, thereby dishonouring the Father.

They teach that Satan bore our sins (not Jesus Christ), because he was the scapegoat of Leviticus 16. That's a LIE!! They teach that Satan will reign on earth which they call "the bottomless pit" for 1000 years. This is a LIE: it is the abyss of Hell. Jesus Christ will reign

with His people on earth for 1000 years. He is the King of Kings!

For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures; And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures: And that he was seen of Cephus, and then of the twelve: [I Corinthians 15:3-5]

I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years. [Revelation 20:4]

8. Adventists preach a **false gospel**.

Adventists teach that Biblical salvation is a process based on works, and not a distinct spiritual conversion (new birth). They LIE!

Lydia was saved by a river...whose heart the Lord opened, (when) she attended unto the things which were spoken of Paul. [Acts 16:14] Cornelius, the Roman centurion, and his household were saved when...Peter; Who shall tell thee words, whereby thou and all thy house shall be saved. And as I began to speak, the Holy Ghost fell on them, as on us at the beginning...Then hath God also to the Gentiles granted repentance unto life. [Acts 11:13pt,14-15, 18]. Many more verses in the Scriptures show salvation is not a process but a distinct, sudden conversion.

1. Adventists follow the teachings of a misguided woman "spiritual leader."
